## 2024 BENTON COUNTY FAIR ENDURO RULES

This event will take place after the Trailer Races. Will take place on the same track as the Trailer Races. Drivers will race around or through all carriage left on the track from that race. This race will be for 20 laps or 20 minutes.

Any stock, 4 or 6 cylinder FWD passenger car, minivan, or SUV is allowed. No trucks.

No race cars

Air bags must be removed or dismantled.

No holes in floor board or firewall.

All body parts required.

Remove all glass including headlights and tail lights.

Windshields are allowed.

If removed driver must be protected. (3/8" support braces or wire mesh)

Seat belts are required and must be worn.

All seats must have head rest. Racing seats allowed.

Battery must be securely fastened. If moved must be in plastic box.

Stock gas tank must remain in place.

May replace with 8 gallon race or boat tank located in trunk.

All 4- brakes must work.

No angle iron or channel bumpers allowed.

Doors must be chained, wired or welded shut.

Stock OEM wheels. No wheel spacers.

Wheels and tries must be same. (Both fronts same, both rears same)

Passenger car tires only. No race tires.

Radiator must be in stock location.

Stock suspension only.

DOT approved full face helmet is required.

Long sleeve shirts and pants. No open shoes.

RECOMMEND full post roll cage. Door plates recommended.

No radio communication allowed.

Divers must be 18 years of age.

Entry Fee is \$20 per vehicle.

Only one driver per car.

Transponders will be used for scoring. Rental is \$10

Random drawing at registration will determine starting order.
